# Why the SPREAD Social Platform?

- Nexus among energy, environment, transport and land use
- Improvement in collaboration among policies but still many "compartments"
- Small energy consumers" transport and households - have increased more their energy consumption than large energy consumers
- Need to improve environmental performance of firms and of products (labels, LCA, eco-design, recyclability, externalities, efficiency...)



### Wealth and quality of life Beyond GDP?





# Energy by the end of the century (BAU)

Energy for mobility will increase by a factor 5

- Energy for thermal comfort and living-space heating and cooling will triple
- Energy used for food will double
