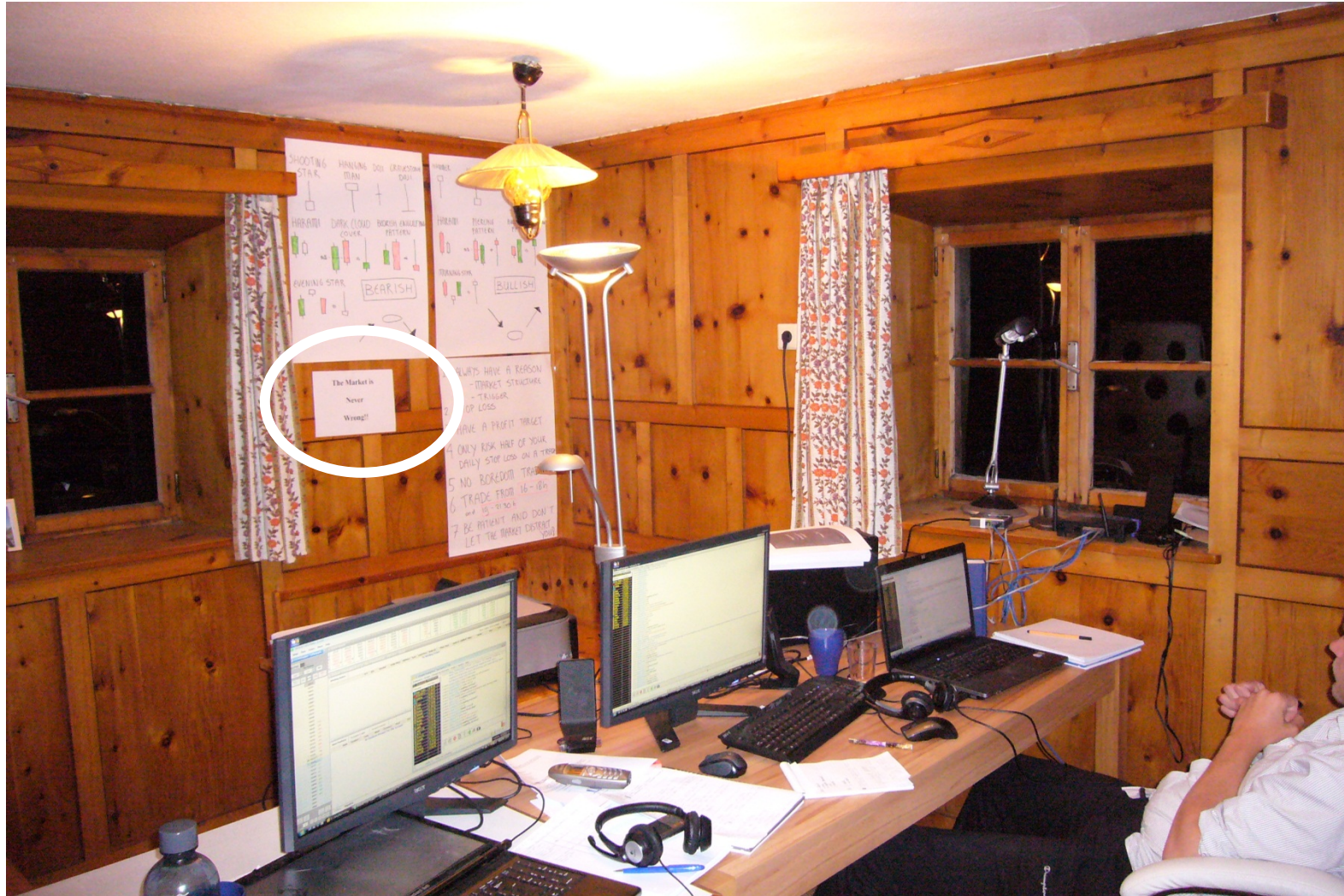

# Ubuntu
